# Call for Applicants:

## Volunteer Lecturer in India

Professors Without Borders is delighted to announce its second and expanded Summer Schools in Lucknow, India. This year, we have partnered with **two all-women universities**: Karamat Girls College, and Avadh Girls' P.G. College to provide short courses and workshops to 60 students over **two weeks** in August 2019.

We are currently looking for four volunteers to teach courses in one of the following: **design thinking, communications, public speaking, psychology, international politics, gender studies, civil society, entrepreneurship**. Our courses are skills-focused and interactive. We also conduct workshops in the community to assist small businesses locally.

We are looking for two lecturers from **5 to 16 August** to volunteer at Avadh Girls' P.G. College; and two women lecturers from **19 to 30 August** to volunteer at Karamat Girls College.

Professors Without Borders will cover all accommodation, visa and transportation costs (Economy) to and from Lucknow. Applicants must bear in mind that they may be asked to teach with few resources available and that logistics within Lucknow may require patience and flexibility.

The courses are geared towards young women. Teachers are responsible for developing their course with the guidance of Prowibo and the host university.

We focus on skills-building and confidence-building in small classes of maximum 25 students. Teachers must adhere to our teaching philosophy of being student-focused. Applicants with experience teaching entry-level courses and who can lead project-based seminars are preferred. An excellent command of English is required.

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Applicants are asked to send a statement of teaching philosophy (250 words maximum) and an updated resume.

## Job Specifications

The main purpose of this role is to commit to teaching adults for a 2-week period. Teachers will have to prepare all didactic and reading material in advance to hand out to students in a book that will be created by Professors Without Borders. **Material must be ready by July 1<sup>st</sup>.** Classes will take place over two weeks with opportunities to volunteer or travel before the start or after the program ends.

Teachers will instruct small cohorts of 20-30 students for a maximum of 6 hours daily. They may also be asked to participate in teacher training, take part in workshops with local instructors, and take on some administrative tasks. **Applicants with filming/photography skills are particularly encouraged to support the documentation of our summer school.**
